- Applicants will be selected by the Greater El Paso Football Showcase Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time nonrenewable basis in the amount of \$1,000.

Eligibility: To be eligible for the Greater El Paso Football Showcase Scholarship a student must:

- ✓ Be a senior student completing his/her education during the award year, and met all graduation requirements as set forth by the state of Texas by June 2022.
- ✓ Participated in the 29th Annual Greater El Paso Senior All Star Football Classic (attends practices and remains for entire game until dismissed by sponsor).
- ✓ Senior football players, trainers, cheerleaders, mascots, dancers/drill team, band members, flag corps, JROTC, journalism, and choir members are eligible to apply.
- ✓ Scholarship money may only be used for tuition and books paid to the attending college or university.
